I would say Congratulations on finding THE company to do this for you! They installation of our wind turbine, and the education process that came along with it have been extremely rewarding. Charles Crumpley and his crew are "good people." They did a professional job and I am thankful to have found them.

I want to encourage you to go through with whatever Charles suggests. He knows his business! Because I live in Sachse, I had to go by their building codes, which did not include anything like this. Charles held our hand all the way through the process, turning what was a deal-stopping fear of city compliance, into "just another day at the office."

If you ask me how much we're saving because of the turbine, I will honestly not be able to tell you. We don't monitor the electricity it is generating other than every once in awhile when it's spinning good, we go out to the electric meter at the back of our property to see if it's really turning backwards.....and it does/did. Oncore installed a new digital meter recently which I have not figured out how to read. I can tell you that our electric bills last Spring were less than half what they were the Spring before we got the turbine, and we're expecting this coming March through June to be the same. I use these months as an example because we are an all-electric estate and use quite a bit of electricity in extreme weather months like July-September, and December - February. Even still, our bills this December and January were down considerably over the same months the year before the tower was installed.

Good luck! If you live in the area, come take a look first-hand.

We Know Technologies makes it as easy on you as it would be just calling the electric company and having service turned on at your home, they handle everything. All you need to do is tell them where to put it.

We installed the wind generator when we built the house a year and a half ago so I dont have comparison of before and after but I dont mind at all telling you what our electric bills have been over the last year. Our home is 3100sqft, 10ft ceilings in the main living areas the rest are 8ft, 2 heat pump a/c units, 2 off the shelf hot water heaters from home depot, I use compact flourescent light bulbs, and we have two wood burning fireplaces (fireplaces are not the most efficient things to have in the house) and our electric bills have been this...

turbine a different way and ended up costing me less than originally planned. Whenever we build our house we are planning on putting 2 turbines up and I will give them a call for the installation. All the electrical work was done to the specs and the foundation is well engineered. I have a brother-in-law that is in the large construction industry and he told me that the way the foundation is engineered is above and beyond.

On a side note, the wind turbine itself is very quite, when the wind is blowing hard and the turbine is at max output, the noise of the wind is louder than the turbine itself. also don't forget that there is a 30% federal income tax credit, which is basically \$5K in cash per turbine.
